NOTICE is hereby given to persons residing within the limits of the Local Board of Badulla that the Board, acting under the provisions of section 35 of the Ordinance No. 13 of 1898, has resolved, that on account of the year 1902 a tax, payable in six days' labour, be imposed upon all persons residing within the limits of the said Board, who, if the Ordinance No. 31 of 1884 had not been passed, would have been liable, under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, to the performance of labour for the maintenance of the roads or other public means of communication by land or by water.

Such labour may be commuted by a money payment of Rs. 2 on or before March 31, 1902.
