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MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, September 20, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated September 14, 1901.

Present:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna; Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. P. D. Warren; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of August 9, 1901, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of August 9, 1901, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. H. A. Jayewardene asked—Whether the road in front of the Supreme Court and the road behind the Supreme and District Courts are vested in the Municipal Council or in Government. The Chairman replied in the negative, whereupon Mr. Jayewardene, by leave of Council, amended his motion—That this Council do request Government to repair them and to keep them in good order and condition, as follows:—That the attention of Government be called to the bad state of the roads and the quadrangle attached to the courts.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

2. Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That the motion standing in his name be amended as follows:—To move that steps be taken to widen the southern end of Seabeach road, and that this motion be deferred until next Meeting of Council.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

3. The following motion standing in Mr. Coomaraswamy's name was, by leave of Council, withdrawn:—To move that cocoanut trees overhanging roads be cut down.

4. By leave of Council Dr. Solomon Fernando moved the motion of which notice was given by Mr. Coomaraswamy amended as follows:—That the petition of the residents of Mutwal regarding arrears of assessment tax be considered and referred to the Chairman for disposal.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

5. The following extracts from Minutes of the Standing Committee of August 23, September 6, and September 17, 1901, were laid before the Council :—

August 23, 1901.

- (5) Letter No. 640 of July 15, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, forwarding time tables and supplementary estimate for Rs. 2,000 for watering streets.
Circulate to Ward Members for suggestions, with agreement with Boustead Brothers. The Committee are of opinion that an extension of street watering is necessary, and authorize the Chairman to temporarily employ the new carts where he thinks necessary, and they pass the estimate subject to any modification that may be found necessary after consulting the Ward Members.
- (13) Papers with reference to town survey.
The Committee recommend to Council that the town plan be brought up to date for purposes of assessment, and they are of opinion that the surveyor employed might at the same time indicate encroachments, which can be specially dealt with as discovered.
- (14) Application for an increase in the votes for Salaries, Wages, and Allowances for 1901 of the Health Department, Rs. 6,500.
Passed.
- (20) Papers with reference to post-mortem instruments for the Veterinary Surgeon.
Resolved that they should be provided. Chairman to arrange.
- (22) Papers with reference to purchase of hoses for manual fire engines.
Approved the purchase of the necessary hose for the manuals to be of canvas or leather, as Major Knollys recommends.
- (27) Memorandum dated August 20, 1901, from Secretary, suggesting the employment of division officers, assistants to prepare warrants, Commutation Department, Rs. 68.
Approved.
- (29) Estimate for gravelling the roads in Kanatta Cemetery, Rs. 1,225.
Passed.
- (32) Estimate for repairing a road at the night soil depôt, Narahenpitiya, Rs. 217.
Passed.
- (33) Estimate for repair of sewer, Dam street, Rs. 253.
Passed.
- (34) Estimate for locked up mutton stalls, Kollupitiya market, Rs. 474.
Approved, provided the stall-holders agree to pay Rs. 10 a month instead of Rs. 6.
- (35) Estimate for improvements to guides' shelter, Rs. 240.
Passed.

September 6, 1901.

- (2) Letter No. 67/013247 of August 9, 1901, from Colonial Secretary, with reference to amended by-laws. Approved the payment of Rs. 125 each to Mr. John de Silva and Mr. H. M. Casie Chitty for Sinhalese and Tamil translations of the by-laws.
- (3) Letter No. B 80 of August 10, 1901, from the Director, Royal Botanic Gardens, forwarding report of the Entomologist on the lake fly nuisance.
Resolved that the Superintendent of Works do furnish rough estimates of the cost of each of the methods suggested by Mr. Green and Dr. Chalmers.
- (6) Letter No. 840 of August 26, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, applying for nine months' leave to proceed to England.
The Committee recommend that leave for three months on full pay and six months on half pay be granted, and the Council make provision for paying Mr. Skelton's *locum tenens* at the same rate as Mr. Skelton.
- (7) Memorandum dated August 28, 1901, by Chairman, with reference to dog cages, 12 cages, Rs. 600.
Approved the cost of providing a dog cage for each police station of the pattern recommended by the Veterinary Surgeon.
- (14) Letter No. 823 of August 21, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, forwarding an amended estimate for Rs. 537-93 for metalling St. Mary's road in lieu of estimate No. 65/38 of 1900 for Rs. 325-08
Approved.
- (24) Estimate for repairs and improvements to Dematagoda slaughter-house buildings.
Resolved that Nos. 1 to 4, 6 to 10, 13 and 14 be taken up and funds provided.
- (25) Estimate for repair of culverts at the junction of 2nd Cross street with Prince street, Rs. 82-50.
Approved.
- (29) Estimate for rebuilding a broken culvert in Seabeach road, Rs. 51-75.
Approved.
- (30) Estimate for whitewashing and painting sexton's quarters, Kanatta, Rs. 112.
Approved.
- (40) Letter No. 881 of August 31, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, with reference to the payments to be made to Mr. L. Hosken for the report on lands at Mutwal to be acquired for the purpose of a quarry.
Resolved that a fee of Rs. 50 be paid to Mr. Hosken.
- (47) Estimate for covers for ball-tap cisterns in public latrines, Rs. 173.
Approved.
- (58) Supplementary vote of Rs. 4,000 for commission to commutation collectors.
Approved.

September 17, 1901.

- (4) Letter No. 840 of August 26, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, applying for nine months' leave to proceed to England.
With reference to the resolution No. 6 of 6th instant, the Committee further recommend that the services of Mr. Pigott should be obtained, if possible, as the *locum tenens* of the Superintendent of Works, it being understood that this appointment will in no way prejudice any future claims of the Assistant Municipal Engineer, which should be considered on their merits. They are of opinion that the appointment of Mr. Pigott is desirable in the exigencies of the present case.
- (6) Papers with reference to licensed guides being allowed to go on board of steamers.
Read. The Committee express regret that the Agent of the Peninsular and Oriental Company should have thrown difficulties in the way of satisfactorily organizing the service of guides, and that he should have refused to assign any good reason for doing so.

- (15) Estimate and construction of certain roads at the night soil depôt, Narahenpitiya, Rs. 422-37. Approved. Chairman will see if gravel can be obtained near the spot at a cheaper rate.
- (16) Estimate for post and rail fence, MacCarthy place, Rs. 846. Approved.
- (19) Letter No. 815 of September 7, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, with reference to drainage, approach road to Kollupitiya station. Approved the additional expenditure (approximately estimated at Rs. 500) for the diversion required by the Railway authorities. The work meanwhile to proceed.
- (23) Estimate for fixing water cart indicator, Rs. 106. Approved.
- (24) Supplementary estimate for setting back boundary wall, Malay street, Rs. 260. Approved. Statement of work done to be furnished.
- (28) Auditor-General's further remarks on query No. 280 on the account of the Works Department for June, 1900. The Committee recommend the Council to pass the charge.
- (51) Estimate for improvements to cross road from Cemetery street, Kotahena, Rs. 686. The Committee approve of the Superintendent of Works' report, and are unable to recommend this scheme.

Mr. A de A. Seneviratna moved :—

- (1) Regarding item No. 13 of Minutes of Standing Committee of August 23, the omission of the words "and they are of opinion that the surveyor employed might at the same time indicate encroachments which can be specially dealt with as discovered."
- (2) Regarding No. 14 of August 23, that the papers be circulated, and that the Chairman continue meanwhile to pay the Department as at present.
- (3) That the other recommendations of August 23, including No. 13 as amended, be adopted.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved :—

- (1) As regards item No. 2 of Minutes of September 6, 1901, the insertion of the words "or any person the Chairman may select" after the words "H. M. Casie Chitty."
- (2) As regards No. 6 of September 6, the deletion of the words "at the same rate as Mr. Skelton," and the substitution for them of the words "at the usual rates allowed in the Public Service for acting officers."
- (3) As regards No. 4 of September 17, that the following be substituted for the recommendation of the Standing Committee: "that Mr. Dassenaik, Assistant Municipal Engineer, be appointed as *locum tenens* of the Superintendent of Works during his absence."

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded. Motions 1 and 2 were carried without division.

The motion was therefore carried.

Dr. Solomon Fernando moved, as regards No. 51 of September 17, that the papers be circulated, and the matter deferred.

Mr. Jas. Peiris seconded.—Carried.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna moved the adoption of the recommendations of September 6 and 17 as amended above.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

6. A report of the Special Committee appointed to consider the question of filling up the vacancy caused by Mr. M. Cochran's retirement, and to submit a report showing the nature of the duties to be performed by the officer who succeeds Mr. Cochran, and making a recommendation as to the amount of his salary and allowances, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. A. Alwis moved the adoption of the report and of the duties attached to it, subject to the addition that the duties shall in each case be "and such other duties as are usually performed by Gas Inspectors and City Analysts and Electrical Advisers to Municipal Corporations generally."

Seconded by Mr. H. A. Jayawardene and carried.

At the request of Mr. C. Perera the Council authorized the deletion of the note he had entered on the report, viz., "I do not remember that we discussed the question of 'leave,' except pension and horse allowance."

7. A report of the Special Committee appointed to consider whether the Colombo lake should be retained in the Council's charge or Government requested to take it over was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved—(1) the adoption of the report with the insertion of the words "when the time arrives" after the words "Council in carrying out;" and (2) the adoption of the estimates for a pontoon and steady boat which were recommended by the Standing Committee in their resolutions Nos. 24 and 25 of July 23, 1901.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

8. A report of the Special Committee appointed on June 11, 1901, to consider the Chairman's Administration Report for 1900, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene moved the adoption of the report and the additions suggested by Mr. C. Perera, with the exception of the sentence "We deprecate the habit of retailing milk in bottles, and recommend that all milk vendors be obliged to use covered block tin cans of a standard measure marked with the Council's stamp."

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

The Chairman informing the Council that he does not acquiesce in the opinion of his predecessor (mentioned by Mr. C. Perera) regarding the proposed change in the system of collecting the consolidated rate.

9. A letter No. 78/015129 of September 6, 1901, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, with reference to resolution of Council of August 9, 1901, regarding dog tax, was read.

10. A letter No. 80/015490 of September 7, 1901, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, with reference to acquisition of land at Mutwal for the purposes of a metal quarry, was read.

The Chairman undertook to address Government further on the subject.

11. A letter dated August 22, 1901, from Mr. M. Cochran, retired Gas Inspector, requesting that his pension may be remitted to him direct in England monthly by bank draft, and that in remitting the rupee may be calculated at 1s. 10½d. sterling, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That Mr. Cochran's pension be remitted to him at the rate of 1s. 10½d. to the rupee.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

12. Draft notice, tender form, and specification, with reference to giving out the Health Department work on contract for 1902, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That this matter be discussed at a Meeting to be held on Friday, the 27th instant.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

13. Papers relating to appointment of an additional clerk to the Municipal Court on a salary of Rs. 20 a month were laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That the appointment be sanctioned.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.

14. A letter dated August 15, 1901, from the Ceylon Ice and Cold Storage Company, thanking Council for agreeing to accept a sum of half cent a pound for the inspection of their imported frozen meat, was read.

15. Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That the required authority of Council be given to waive cost on vehicles and animals tax referred to in Audit queries Nos. 567, 568, and 572 on the revenue accounts for November, 1900.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

16. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to August 31, 1901, and Progress Report of Work done for August, 1901, were laid on the table.

17. Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for May, 1901, were laid on the table.

18. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder, were laid on the table.

19. A letter No. 83/016612 of September 14, 1901, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, forwarding for consideration an extract from the report of the Cattle Murrain Committee regarding a quarantine station for imported cattle, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That this question be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Dr. Allan Perry, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G., Mr. P. D. Warren, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy, and Dr. Solomon Fernando—three to form a quorum.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

DISSENT.

Under chapter V., section 9, of the by-laws, I record the reason of my dissent from the opinion of the majority on the motion of Mr. Coomaraswamy regarding the appointment of a *locum tenens* of the Superintendent of Works during the latter's leave :—

- (1) Because it is likely to disarrange the working of the Department. The division of work is, roughly that the Superintendent of Works attends to works of construction and the Assistant Municipal Engineer to upkeep works. The Assistant Municipal Engineer will be new to the former and his *locum tenens*, whoever he is, to the latter. Had Mr. Pigott's services been obtained both classes of work would have been attended to by officers acquainted with them.
- (2) Because the two professional Members of the Council, Messrs. Cooper and Warren, are of opinion that Mr. Dassenaike is not sufficiently experienced to undertake the duties of Superintendent of Works.
- (3) Because I am not prepared to accept responsibility for the Works Department, while an officer is at the head of it, who is, in the opinion of the two Members best able to advise the Council on the subject, insufficiently experienced to undertake the duties.
