Pursuant to notice, Dr. Anthonisz moved,—That the following motion submitted to this Council at the Meeting held in July last and seconded by the Fort Member, and deferred for consideration pending the receipt of a legal opinion on the Council's right to adopt such a motion, be now considered, as a legal opinion has since been obtained affirming the Council's right, in the following terms:—That in the opinion of the Council all road work should be done by contract, and that in the exercise of the power vested in the Chairman under the 63rd and following clauses of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance any resolution to that effect adopted by the Council be given effect to by the Chairman in terms of the proviso to section 47 (1) of the same Ordinance, as amended by section 12 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896.

The motion, by leave of Council, was amended by the omission of words "in the following terms" before the words "That in the opinion of the Council." It was then seconded by Dr. Ludovici.

The motion was discussed, Messrs. D. G. Goonawardena, C. P. Hayley, N. Dias Abeysinha, H. A. Grant, and
