MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Thursday, October 17, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated October 11, 1901.

Present:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Mr. A. Perry; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. P. D. Warren; Mr. D. W. H. Skrine; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of September 20 and 27, 1901, having been printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of September 20 and 27, 1901, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That steps be taken to widen Seabeach road. Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

2. The following extracts from the Minutes of the Standing Committee of September 17 and October 4, 1901, were laid before the Council:—

September 17, 1901.

- (51) Estimate for improvements to Cross road from Cemetery street, Kotahena, Rs. 686. The Committee approve of the Superintendent of Works' report, and are unable to recommend this scheme.

October 4, 1901.

- (5) Letter dated September 16, 1901, from Messrs. Delmege, Forsyth & Company, applying for permission to lay down an underground pipe line to convey petroleum from Kochchikada to the Railway premises at Maradana Junction and to the main goods yard.

The Committee are of opinion that the Council has no power to grant the permission asked for, and in any case they are not prepared to recommend it.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

3. The Supplemental Budget No. 4, which received the approval of the Standing Committee on October 4, 1901, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the Supplemental Budget No. 4 be sanctioned.

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

4. A letter No. 8/017682 of October 1, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the report of the Special Committee appointed to consider whether the Colombo lake should be retained on the Council's charge or Government requested to take it over, was read.

5. A letter No. 92/015899 of October 8, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the proposal to widen entrance to Seabeach road, was read.

6 and 7. Memoranda dated October 5 and 8, 1901, by the Chairman, with reference to the method of recovering vehicles and animals tax, and proposing certain measures to facilitate the proper assessment of properties, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

MUNICIPALITY OF KANDY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall, Kandy, on Saturday, September 21, 1901, at 8.30 o'clock a.m., in accordance with Notice dated September 17.

Present :—Hon. Mr. H. Wace, Chairman ; J. H. Sproule, Esq. ; C. Vanderwall, Esq. ; R. W. Jonklaas, Esq. ; L. Creasy, Esq. ; P. T. Habeeboo Lebbe, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on August 31 were read, confirmed, and signed by the Chairman.

2. The following documents were submitted :—Statements of Receipts and Expenditure from close of 1900 to August 31, 1901, on account of the Municipal Fund, comprising the (No. 1) General Revenue, (No. 2) Consolidated Rate (Police and Lighting), and (No. 3) Water-rate Accounts ; Progress Report of Works done brought up to the same date ; Health Officer's Report for, and Statement of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of August.

Resolved,—That the several statements, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, and the Health Officer's report, be forwarded to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. The following papers were laid on the table :—Reports by the several Inspectors on laundries inspected during August and register.

4. Read Auditor's report that he had examined the books for August and found them correct.

Read letter No. 89 dated September 7 from the Government Agent, submitting the following offers for Municipal tolls for 1902, and recommending that they be accepted :—

Halolluwa ferry	Rs. 480
Illukmodara and Kundasale ferries	Rs. 720

The papers had been circulated.

Resolved,—That the offers made be accepted.

6. Read petition dated September 19, 1901, from Sinna Marikar Ahamedo Lebbe Marikar, owner of premises No. 252, Colombo street, respecting the notice served on him to close the cesspit on his premises in accordance with the resolution of the Council (No. 11) of August 31.

Resolved,—That the application to rescind the notice served to close the cesspit be refused, and Sinna Marikar Ahamedo Lebbe Marikar be informed that the terms of the order must be complied with.

7. Submitted petition from certain residents praying for a reduction of the charge for removal of night soil, and which had been circulated amongst the Members.

Proposed by Mr. Sproule, seconded by Mr. Vanderwall, that the petition be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Messrs. Sproule, Vanderwall, and Habeeboo Lebbe.

The motion was put to the Meeting and carried.

8. Read the following recommendation by the Standing Committee on a memorandum by the Chairman respecting a movement to introduce carp and other fish into the lake, and other places:—That a payment of a contribution of Rs. 150 towards the introduction of fish experiment scheme—equivalent to amount already subscribed—be made.

Resolved,—That the recommendation be accepted.

9. The Chairman's Annual Report, which had been circulated, was submitted.

On proposal by Mr. Vanderwall, seconded by Mr. Habeeboo Lebbe, resolved that the report be printed and referred to a Special Committee consisting of Messrs. Sproule, Beven, Vanderwall, and Creasy.

10. The report by Special Committee on proposed rules and regulations respecting water supply was ordered to remain over for a fuller Meeting.

11. Read petition dated September 12, 1901, from owners and occupiers of premises Nos. 6 to 33, Katugastota road, stating their grievances in respect of notices issued to close the cesspits on their several premises and to substitute dry-earth closets.

The following memorandum read:—The closing of cesspits recommended by Dr. Keyt in April, 1900, notices served. Petition received from residents dated October 3.

Chairman and Health Officer inspected premises November 5; report submitted; Council November 17; reply sent; cesspit must be closed.

Resolved,—That the petitioners be informed that there is no reason to suspend the order made, as access for removal of night soil by coolies is open without disturbance to the inmates of houses.

12. In accordance with notice, Mr. Vanderwall proposed, Mr. Sproule seconded, that steps be taken, under by-law No. 22, to suspend or revoke the license granted to Mohideen Pitcha for stall No. 69, on the ground that the stall has not been used for serving the public during the last two months.

Resolved,—That Mohideen Pitcha, occupier of stall No. 69, be noticed to re-open the stall for trade before October 1 and to keep it open, otherwise the license issued to him will be cancelled.
