MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Thursday, October 17, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated October 11, 1901.

Present:—Mr. A. S Pagden, Chairman; Mr. A. Perry; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. P. D. Warren; Mr. D. W. H. Skrine; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of September 20 and 27, 1901, having been printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of September 20 and 27, 1901, be confirmed.

- 1. Pursuant to notice, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That steps be taken to widen Seabeach road. Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.
- 2. The following extracts from the Minutes of the Standing Committee of September 17 and October 4, 1901, were laid before the Council:—

September 17, 1901.

(51) Estimate for improvements to Cross road from Cemetery street, Kotahena, Rs. 686.

The Committee approve of the Superintendent of Works' report, and are unable to recommend this scheme.

October 4, 1901.

(5) Letter dated September 16, 1901, from Messrs. Delmege, Forsyth & Company, applying for permission to lay down an underground pipe line to convey petroleum from Kochchikada to the Railway premises at Maradana Junction and to the main goods yard.

The Committee are of opinion that the Council has no power to grant the permission asked for, and in any case they are not prepared to recommend it.

(13) Letter dated September 25, 1901, from the Hongkong and Shanghai Bank, with reference to interest for fixed deposits.

Resolved that the Rs. 100,000 be deposited for six months in the Hongkong and Shanghai Bank.

(43) Ordinance to amend and consolidate the Law relating to Carriages, Carts, and Coaches.

Resolved that the Chairman do point out to Government the probable loss of revenue, and ask for an amendment of the Ordinance.

(45) Papers regarding lighting of Green Path.

Estimates to be obtained and money provided under gas extension contract.

(46) Papers regarding lighting of Captain's Garden. To be taken up under gas extension contract.

The Chairman moved—That Council do go into Committee. Mr. James Peiris seconded,—Carried.

[Council in Committee.]

Council having resumed, Dr. Solomon Fernando moved-That item No. 51 of September 17, 1901, be referred back to the Standing Committee for reconsideration, and that the Chairman be authorized to spend whatever funds the Committee approve of.

Mr. James Peiris seconded.—Carried.

With regard to item No. 5 of October 4, 1901, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved.—That the Council are not prepared to grant the permission asked for.

Mr. James Peiris seconded.—Carried.

Mr. James Peiris moved—That the remaining extracts contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

3. The Supplemental Budget No. 4, which received the approval of the Standing Committee on October 4, 1901, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved — That the Supplementel Budget No. 4 be sanctioned.

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

- 4. A letter No. 8/017682 of October 1, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the report of the Special Committee appointed to consider whether the Colombo lake should be retained on the Council's charge or Government requested to take it over, was read.
- 5. A letter No. 92/015899 of October 8, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the proposal to widen entrance to Seabeach road, was read.
- 6 and 7. Memoranda dated October 5 and 8, 1901, by the Chairman, with reference to the method of recovering vehicles and animals tax, and proposing certain measures to facilitate the proper assessment of properties, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Chairman moved—That the Council do go into Committee.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.

[Council in Committee.]

Council having resumed, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That the memoranda be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G., Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G., Mr. D. W. H. Skrine, Mr. C. Ferera, Mr. Arthur Alvis, Mr. James Peiris, and Dr. Solomon Fernando —three to form a quorum—and that the Committee be authorized to deal with such other proposals as may be brought up before the Committee by the Chairman.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded. - Carried.

8. Papers with reference to erection of two booths covered with tarpaulin without permission at No. 255, Dematagoda, were laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That Chairman be empowered to give notice under section 176 (a) of Ordinance

No. 7 of 1887.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

9. An application from Mr. Goonewardene, Second Draughtsman, Works Department, for twelve days' leave from September 11, 1901, was laid before the Council.

Dr. Solomon Fernando moved—That the leave be granted.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

10. Papers with reference to the Health Department contract were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Council resolved to go into Committee.

Council having resumed, Dr. Solomon Fernando moved—That the contract be approved. Mr. A. Perry seconded.—Carried.

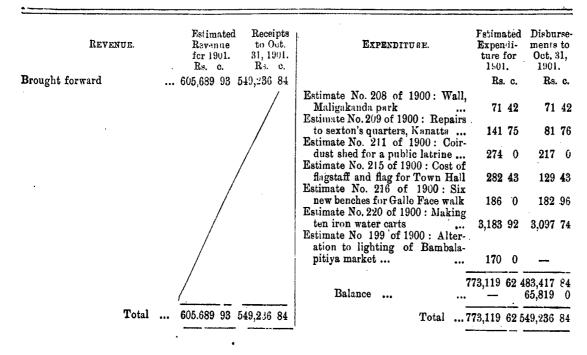

 Resolved,—That the several statements, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, and the Health Officer's report, be forwarded to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the Government Garactic.

Resolved,—That the application to rescind the notice served to close the cesspit be refused, and Sinna Marikar Ahamedo Lebbe Marikar be informed that the terms of the order must be complied with.

7. Submitted petition from certain residents praying for a reduction of the charge for removal of night soil, and which had been circulated amongst the Members.

Proposed by Mr. Sproule, seconded by Mr. Vanderwall, that the petition be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Messrs. Sproule, Vanderwall, and Habeeboo Lebbe. The motion was put to the Meeting and carried.

8. Read the following recommendation by the Standing Committee on a memorandum by the Chairman respecting a movement to introduce carp and other fish into the lake, and other places:—That a payment of a contribution of Rs. 150 towards the introduction of fish experiment scheme—equivalent to amount already subscribed-be made.

Resolved,—That the recommendation be accepted.

General Health of Town. -Good, with the exception of two or three cases of chickenpox. No infectious diseases in the town; these were seen by myself, isolated, and treated in their own houses.
