LOCAL BOARD NOTICES.

T N accordance with the requirements of section 4 of the Opium and Bhang Ordinance, No. 2 of 1893, I hereby give notice that there will be one license for the sale by retail of opium within the limits of the Local Board town of Badulla for the year commencing from January 1, 1899. 7. In the event of any re-sale realizing a smaller amount than that at which the highest bidder at the previous sale had been declared the purchaser, such highest bidder shall be liable for the difference, which shall be recoverable by action in a Court of Requests.

8. The holder of the license for the sale by wholesale or retail of opium, who sells or allows any person to sell opium to any person apparently under the age of fifteen years, will have his license cancelled as well as be prosecuted.
