NOTICE UNDER ORDINANCE No. 1 OF 1897.

[An Ordinance relating to Claims to Forest, Chena, Waste, and Unoccupied Lands.]

WHEREAS it appears to me, Henry Luttrell Moysey, Government Agent for the Province of Sabaragamuwa, that the land hereinafter described is forest land, I do hereby, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the 1st section of Ordinance No. 1 of 1897, declare that if no claim to the said land be made to me at the Ratnapura Kachcheri within three months from the date of this notice, the said land shall be deemed the property of the Crown, and may be dealt with on account of the Crown.

And I do further give notice that if no claim to the said land or any interest therein is made to me as aforesaid, I will, at the expiration of the said three months, declare by writing under my hand that the said land is the property of the Crown.
