Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 1 of 1904.

An Ordinance for making final provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the Year 1902.

HENRY A. BLAKE.

Preamble.

THEREAS by an Ordinance No. 19 of 1902 it was enacted that a sum of Rs. 1,868,185.29 should be charged upon the revenue of this island for the Supplementary Contingent Services of the year One thousand Nine hundred and Two, in addition to the sum of Rs. 21,326,401 provided by the Ordinance No. 16 of 1901: And whereas an expenditure of Rs. 112,744-12 was incurred and brought to account for the Contingent Services of the year 1902, for which provision is not made by the aforesaid Ordinances: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 112,744-12 charged upon the revenue of this island of the year 1902 for the final Supplementary Contingent Service of that year.

1 That a sum not exceeding One hundred and Twelve thousand Seven hundred and Forty-four rupees and Twelve cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this island of the said year 1902, for the services hereinafter mentioned; the said expenditure being in conformity with the schedule hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract:

DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to further amend the Law relating to the General Regulation of Customs.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend in certain particulars the Ordinances relating to the general regulation of customs: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

2 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Customs Duties Amendment Ordinance, 1904," and this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, and the Ordinances amending the same shall be read and construed as one Ordinance, and may be cited together as "The Customs Duties Ordinances, 1869 to 1904."

Further provise as to sanction of Secretary of State to notifications and resolutions under (a) and (b) of section 11 of Ordinance No, 17 of 1869.

- 3 To the further proviso which was added by "The Customs Duties Amendment Ordinance, 1903," to section 11 of Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, the following sub-section shall be added, namely:
 - (c) No notification under sub-section (a) of this proviso and no resolution passed under sub-section (b) thereof shall take effect until such notification or resolution, as the case may be, shall have been submitted to and sanctioned by the Secretary of State, and such sanction shall have been notified in the Government Gazette.
- 4 In schedule D of "The Customs Duties Amendment Ordinance, 1903," the following words shall be added after the words "if exceeding 288 hours, to pay the same rate outwards as paid inwards," namely, "and also a buoy rent, payable on clearance outwards, of fifteen rupees for every day or part of a day of her stay in port after the expiration of such period. Provided that buoy rent shall not be payable in respect of any time beyond the said period during which a sailing vessel has stayed in port for repairs, or because she was unable to put to sea without risk, if the Master Attendant is satisfied that such stay was necessary and was
