





## FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, and 1900, declaring  
Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands called Padawigampolamukalana, Padawigampolakanda, Gaskadurugahamulahena, Denapitiya Gaskadurugahamulahena, situate in the village of Padavigampola in the Kinigoda korale of the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, and 1900."

THE notice required by section 1 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, and 1900," having been duly published in manner prescribed by that section in respect of the above-named lands (*vide* notice No. 539), and no claim having been made to the said lands or to any interest therein within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, the Assistant Government Agent for the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 2 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this Fifth day of February, 1904, order and declare that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, situate in the village of Padawigampola in the Kinigoda korale of the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and shown as lots 3,711 on preliminary plan 4,984 and lots 5,535, 5,536, 5,537½ on preliminary plan 8,137 and in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, and containing in extent 118 acres 2 roods and 3 perches, are the property of the Crown.

*Description of the Lands referred to.*

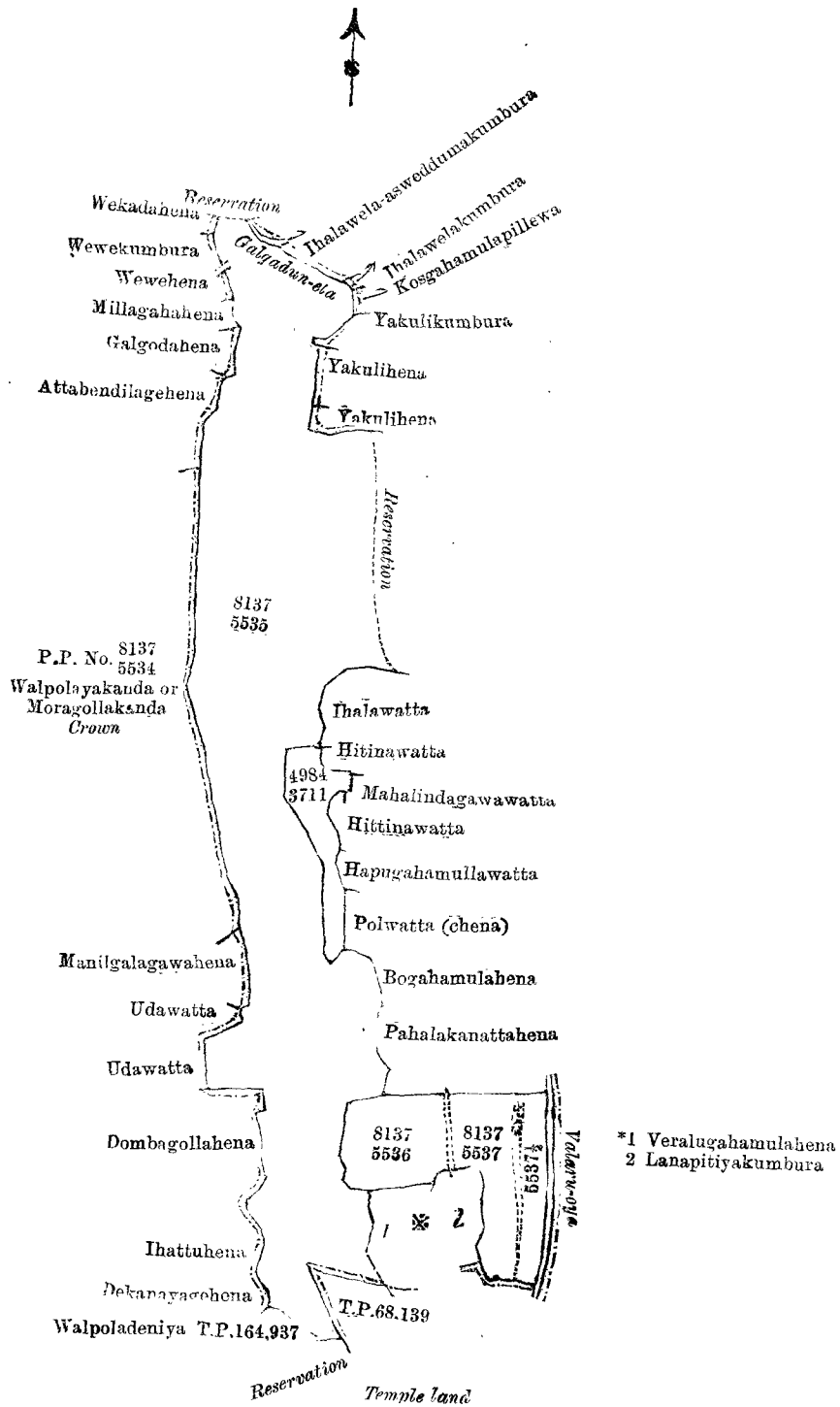

Kiriappuhami; on the west by Dekanayagehena claimed by Mudalihami, Ihattuhena claimed by Dingiri Appu, Dombagollahena claimed by Ukku Menika, Udawatta claimed by Punchi Etana, Udawatta claimed by Kiri Menika, Manilgalagawahena claimed by Ranhami, Walpolayakanda or Moragollakanda (P. P. 8,137, 5,534) claimed by the Crown, Attabendilagehena claimed by Appuhami, Galgodahena claimed by Ranhami, Millagahahena claimed by Appuhami, Wewehena claimed by Ranhami, Wewekumbura claimed by Ranhami, Wekadahena claimed by M. 2. Denapitiyagaskadurugahamulahena (P. P. 8,137, 5,537½): bounded on the north by Pahalakanattahena claimed by Appu, Mudalihami, and Hami; on the east by Valaru-oya; on the south by T. P. 68,139 called Danmadittehena (Temple land) belonging to Kandy Gangarama Vihare and the village boundary of Dahrenpahuwa village; on the west by Denapitiya Gaskadurugahamulahena (P. P. 8,137, 5,537) claimed by D. Punchirala and another.

Order under Section 4, Sub-Section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, and 1900,"  
admitting Land to be Private Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Denapitiyagaskadurugamahulahena, situate in the village of Padawigampola in the Kinigoda korale of the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, and 1900."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the Twenty-fifth day of October, One thousand and Nine hundred, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Denapitiyagaskadurugamahulahena, situate in the village of Padawigampola in the Kinigoda korale of the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, containing in extent 6 acres 3 roods and 22 perches, and shown as lot 5,537 in preliminary plan No. 8,137 as described in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, was made to the Assistant Government Agent of the District of Kegalla within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be deemed the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown :

And whereas Dahanekekarallage Punchirala and Heratmudiyanselage Appuhami, both of Padawigampola, made claim thereto, and the Assistant Government Agent for the Kegalla District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, made due inquiry into such claim, he, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, does hereby admit the claim of the said claimant to the said land, as more fully described herein below, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances.
