FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," admitting Land to be Private Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kosgahahena, situate in the village of Kalupe in the Wellaboda pattuwa of the Galle District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


HEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 19th day of June, One thousand Nine hundred and Three, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Kosgahahena, situate in the village of Kalupe in the Wellaboda pattuwa of the Galle District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 7 acres 3 roods and 26 perches, and shown as lot 14,488 in preliminary plan No. 5,015 and in the annexed certified tracing therefrom, was made to the Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be deemed the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide notice No. 1,560):
