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## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, November 8, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated November 2, 1901.

*Present:*—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Mr. A. Perry; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. P. D. Warren; Mr. D. W. H. Skrine; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of October 17, 1901, having been printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved—That the Minutes of October 17, 1901, be confirmed.

1. The motion standing in the name of Mr. R. H. Morgan was withdrawn by leave of Council.
2. The following recommendations of the Standing Committee of October 25 and November 1, 1901, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

October 25, 1901.

- (4) Letter No. 2,627 of September 30, 1901, from Inspector-General of Police, with reference to licensing carriages.

The Committee approve of an examination to test the driving capabilities of the drivers, and (Mr. Perera dissenting) that their character should be inquired into before they are licensed. They think there are difficulties in the way of testing their knowledge of localities, as places are known by different names in English and the vernacular languages. The by-laws generally seem appropriate. The fee, if any, should be as small as possible.

- (12) Letter dated September 5, 1901, from Veterinary Surgeon, applying for increase of salary. The Committee recommend that the Veterinary Surgeon be paid Rs. 250 per month, provided he devotes the whole of his time to the Council and performs all such duties as the Council may require of him from time to time.
- (22) Letter No. 1,013 of September 27, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, applying for supplementary votes on estimates for :—
- (1) 74, purchase of tools for roads, Rs. 400.
  - (2) 75, purchase of tools for other works, Rs. 100.
  - (3) 76, repair of tools for roads, Rs. 200.

Passed. Circulate papers.

- (23) Letter No. 1,095 of October 12, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, with reference to vote for Dredging St. Sebastian Canal and to transfer a sum of Rs. 1,400 from vote 165 "For Repair of Drains," to vote 85, "Dredging St. Sebastian Canal." Authorized.
- (25) Estimate for repair of fish benches, Dean's road market, Rs. 62. Passed.
- (26) Estimate for repair of fish benches, Kollupitiya market, Rs. 76.80. Passed.
- (27) Estimate for Captain's Garden road, Rs. 2,255. Passed. Chairman will ascertain if the Gas Company will alter at their cost anything required if they are allowed to go on with the gas laying.
- (28) Estimate for repairs to the Lock-gate in St. Sebastian canal, Rs. 500. Passed. Return of materials removed to be kept.
- (29) Estimate for improvements to cross road from Cemetery street, Kotahena, Rs. 686. Superintendent of Works to furnish estimate for repairs of the road only from A to B. Chairman may authorize.
- (30) Estimate for repair of house No. 2, Hulftsdorp street, Rs. 340. Revised estimate of Rs. 222 passed. Chairman will ascertain quantities of roofing and guttering.
- (50) Supplementary vote for capture and destruction of dogs and for dog collars, Rs. 200. Passed. Circulate.
- (82) Papers with reference to inspection of laundries outside Municipal limits. Approved.

*November 1, 1901.*

- (3) Tender for the lease of boutique No. 60, St. John's road, for 1902. Accept.
- (11) Supplementary estimate for coir dust shed for public latrine, Rs. 87.51. Passed. Chairman will inquire into necessity and circulate.
- (19) Letter No. 1,156 of October 30, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, applying for further sum of Rs. 300 for repair of Lock-gate, St. Sebastian canal. Chairman may authorize. Details to be given.

Mr. A. Perry moved—That Council go into Committee.  
The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper seconded.

[Council in Committee,]

Council having resumed, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved—That the recommendations contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

3. A report of the Special Committee appointed on September 20, 1901, to consider the question of providing a quarantine station for imported cattle, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. A. Perry moved the adoption of the report with the first paragraph of the rider and substituting the words "proper authority" for the word "management."

Mr. P. D. Warren seconded.—Carried.

Mr. C. Perera dissenting as regards the 1st clause of the rider only.

4. An interim report of the Special Committee appointed on October 17, 1901, to consider the Chairman's memoranda, with reference to the method of recoveries of vehicles and animals tax and assessment of properties, and to deal with such other proposals as may be brought up before the Committee by the Chairman, was laid before the Council.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene moved—That the recommendations 1 and 2 contained in the report with regard to the Chairman's memoranda be adopted, and that the remainder be circulated with papers.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

5. A letter No. 100/017793 of October 28, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to resolution of Council of September 20, 1901, regarding the roads and the quadrangle attached to the courts, was laid on the table.

6. Applications for the post of Acting Assistant Municipal Engineer were laid before the Council and considered.

Mr. R. H. Morgan moved—That Mr. Albert de Livera be appointed as Acting Assistant Municipal Engineer, subject to the consent of the Government.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.

Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten moved as an amendment that Mr. C. Herft be appointed.  
Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF KANDY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall, Kandy, on Saturday, October 26, 1901, at 8.30 o'clock a.m., in accordance with notice dated October 23.

*Present*:—J. H. Sproule, Esq.; E. Beven, Esq.; C. Vanderwall, Esq.; L. Creasy, Esq.; Dr. J. Craib; P. T. Habeeboo Lebbe, Esq.

1. In the unavoidable absence of the Chairman—resolved that Mr. Sproule take the Chair.

2. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on September 21 were read, confirmed, and signed by the Chairman.

3. The following documents were submitted:—Statements of Receipts and Expenditure from close of 1900 to September 30, 1901, on account of the Municipal Fund, comprising the (No. 1) General Revenue, (No. 2) Consolidated Rate (Police and Lighting), and (No. 3) Water-rate Accounts; Progress Report of Works done brought up to the same date; Health Officer's Report for, and Statement of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of September.

Resolved,—That the several statements, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, and the Health Officer's report, be forwarded to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

Resolved,—That the attention of the Health Officer be called to the delay in sending in his monthly report for September, and he be requested to send it early each month to allow of its being circulated before the Meeting.

4. The following papers were laid on the table:—Reports by the several Inspectors on laundries inspected during September.

Proposed by Mr. Beven, seconded by Mr. Habeeboo Lebbe,—That the attention of the Health Officer be invited to the reports, especially that of Mr. G. Toussaint, of the existence of cesspits at several laundries, and the want of ventilation, and he be asked to make a special report of these premises.

5. In accordance with notice, Mr. P. T. Habeeboo Lebbe asked,—Whether tax is levied on carts which come in habitually to Kandy from Rajawella estate.

*Reply*.—No tax recovered.

6. Mr. Habeeboo Lebbe asked the permission of the Council to postpone till next Meeting, owing to the Chairman's absence, the motion of which he had given notice respecting the establishment of a toll on the Deltota road. This was agreed to.

7. The consideration of the report of the Special Committee on proposed rules and regulations respecting water supply was postponed for a fuller Meeting, and on suggestion of Mr. Vanderwall it was agreed that the proposed rules be again circulated.

8. Read recommendation by the Health Officer that owing to the insanitary state of the cesspits on the following premises, they be closed and dry-earth closets substituted, viz., No. 104, Trincomalee street, owned by O. L. M. Mohammado, No. 7 A to G, Cross street, owned by C. D. A. Abeyratne.

Resolved, on motion of Mr. Vanderwall, seconded by Mr. Beven, that special authority be granted to the Chairman, in accordance with section 209 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, as amended by section 33 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1896, to require the owners of premises No. 104, Trincomalee street, and 7 A to G, Cross street, to empty, disinfect, and close the cesspits on the said several premises and to substitute dry-earth closets therefor.

On being put to the Meeting the motion was carried.

9. Read report by the Chief Inspector of the excessive consumption of water on the following premises:— Nos. 202, 206-8, 252, Colombo street.

Proposed by Mr. Creasy, seconded by Dr. Craib,—That the occupier of premises No. 202, Colombo street, be prosecuted under section 26, chapter XII., of Ordinance No. 19 of 1896, for permitting the use of water to occupiers of premises No. 203 of same street. This was carried.

Proposed by Mr. Vanderwall, seconded by Mr. Habeeboo Lebbe,—That the occupiers of premises Nos. 206-8 and 252, Colombo street, be warned against wasting water on their premises.

10. Read letter dated October 21 from Members of the Municipal Clerical Staff, praying that a scheme be devised for the granting of annual increments of salary.

Proposed by Mr. Beven, seconded by Mr. Vanderwall, that the letter be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Messrs. Sproule, Creasy, and Beven—Carried.

Letter from Mr. Mutukisna, dated October 21, asking for an increase of salary, was ordered to be submitted to the same Committee.

11. Supplemental Budget No. 2, submitted to and approved by the Standing Committee, was considered.

Resolved, on motion by Mr. Beven, seconded by Mr. Vanderwall, that the Supplemental Budget, with a slight amendment as suggested, be adopted and approved of as follows:—
