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DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend "The Irrigation and Paddy Cultivation Ordinance, 1889."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Irrigation and Paddy Cultivation Ordinance, 1889," in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Construction and short title.

1 This Ordinance shall be construed and read as one with Ordinance No. 23 of 1889, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance," Ordinance No. 6 of 1892, and Ordinance No. 10 of 1901, and this Ordinance, the principal Ordinance, and Ordinances No. 6 of 1892 and No. 10 of 1901 may be cited together as "The Irrigation Ordinances, 1889 to 1905."

Amendment of
section 47.

2 To section 47 of the principal Ordinance, as amended by Ordinance No. 10 of 1901, the following proviso shall be added :

Provided further, that whenever Crown lands are benefited by any irrigation work it shall be lawful for the Crown to sell either by public auction or by private contract the whole or any portion or portions of such Crown lands, and to impose such charge in perpetuity on the lands so sold not exceeding two rupees per acre per annum as the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, may from time to time fix, notwithstanding that a charge in perpetuity at a different rate per acre has been fixed and agreed to by a majority of the proprietors of the lands benefited by such work. Notice that such Crown lands will be sold subject to such higher charge in perpetuity shall be given to intending purchasers by publication in at least three consecutive issues of the *Government Gazette* prior to any such sale. Provided further, that the provisions of chapter LX. of the principal Ordinance shall in all respects apply to such higher charge in perpetuity imposed under the provisions of this Ordinance as well as to the charge fixed and agreed to by a majority of the proprietors under the provisions of the principal Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

THIS Ordinance will enable Government to sell Crown land benefited by an irrigation work subject to a higher charge in perpetuity than that fixed and agreed to by a majority of the proprietors, provided that such higher charge shall in no case exceed Rs. 2 per acre.
