GALLE MUNICIPALITY.

OTICE is hereby given that the Municipal Council of Galle, acting under the authority of section 127 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, have made and assessed, with the sanction of the Governor in Executive Council, the following rates for the year 1902:-

(1) A tax of Rs. 5 on every carriage of whatever description other than a cart, hackery, or jinricksha. Carriages licensed to let for hire are exempted from this tax.

(2) A tax of Rs. 4 on every cart or hackery of whatever description. Carts, not hackeries, licensed to let for hire are exempted from this tax.

A tax of Rs. 2.50 on every horse, pony, or mule. A tax of Re. 1 on every bullock or ass.

(5) A tax of 50 cents on every jinricksha.
