MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on February 8, 1902, at 12.30 p.m.

Present :—The Chairman, G. M. Fowler, Esq. ; H. A. Grant, Esq. ; Dr. W. G. Keith ; Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G. ; D. G. Goonawardana, Esq. ; N. Dias Abeysinh, Esq. ; Dr. E. Ludovici ; Magdoon Ismail, Esq. ; and F. Abeyundara, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on January 18, 1902.

2. Read letter from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary dated January 23, 1902, No. 2, forwarding draft of an Ordinance to amend "The Municipal Councils' Ordinances, 1887, 1890, and 1896," and asking the views of the Council thereon.

Moved by Mr. D. G. Goonawardana—That the Council is of opinion that in view of the comparatively small amount of business the Standing Committee has to transact, and of the limited number of Members composing the Council, there is no necessity to make the Ordinance applicable to Galle.

Seconded by Mr. Magdoon Ismail.—Carried.

3. Read letter from the District Engineer, Galle, dated January 25, 1902, No. 28, asking to be informed of the "regulations to make a connection to the water main on the esplanade" to supply water to the Trinity House.

Moved by Dr. Ludovici—That the District Engineer be informed that owing to the insufficiency of the available supply of water the Council is unable to comply with his request, but if it is shown that there is no other way of obtaining the water required, the Council will reconsider the matter.

Seconded by N. Dias Abeysinh, Esq.—Carried.

4. The Chairman applied, in terms of section 33 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896, for authority to notice owner of house No. 44, Pedlar street, to close the cesspit on the premises and to substitute a dry-earth closet therefor.

Resolved—That the Chairman be empowered to issue the notice.

5. Submitted Accounts and Progress Report for January, 1902.

6. Dr. Anthonisz, by leave of Council, moved—That this Council regrets the severance of the Chairman's connection with this Council, and wishes him a pleasant time in Colombo. They congratulate him on his deserved promotion and to a seat in the Legislative Council and wish him a successful administration of the Province, and they desire this to be placed on record.

Carried unanimously.

The Chairman replied thanking the Members for the good wishes expressed in the resolution and the assistance rendered him in the execution of his duties.
