## VITAL STATISTICS OF CEYLON.

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 1904.

### I.—Population.

THE estimated population of the Island on the last day of the quarter was 3,812,931, being an increase of 23,164 on the previous quarter, due to an excess of 12,886 births over deaths, and a further excess of 10,278 arrivals over departures of Indian coolies.

2. *Arrivals and departures of Indian coolies.*—The number of Indian coolies who arrived in the Island during the quarter amounted to 19,769 and of departures to 9,491, as against their respective averages 22,170 and 18,600 for the corresponding quarters of the last six years.

### II.—Marriages.

3. *Marriages.*—4,475 general marriages (*i.e.*, marriages other than Kandyan or Mohammedan) were registered during the quarter and 1,773 Kandyan marriages.

4. Table VI. in the Appendix shows the marriages solemnized in the general community in each Province and district in the Island, the civil condition, nationality, the highest, lowest, and mean ages of the parties, the mode of solemnization, the number of bridegrooms and brides who were unable to sign their names in the register, &c.

5. Table VII. gives similar information in respect of the Kandyan marriages.

6. *First marriages; re-marriages.*—Of the 4,475 general marriages, 3,913 (equal to 87 per cent.) were between bachelors and spinsters, 355 between widowers and spinsters, 107 between bachelors and widows, 84 between widowers and widows, 9 between divorced men and spinsters, 5 between bachelors and divorced women, 1 between a divorced man and a widow, and 1 between a divorced woman and a widower.

7. *Age at marriage.*—The mean age at marriage for the general community was 26·6 for males and 20·6 for females, and for Kandyans 26·1 for males and 19·8 for females.

8. *Minors.*—In the general community about 4 per cent. of the bridegrooms and 51 per cent. of the brides and among the Kandyans 14 per cent. of the bridegrooms and 75 per cent. of the brides, were under 21 years of age.

9. *Mixed marriages.*—There were 45 mixed marriages during the quarter: 3 between Europeans and Burghers, 1 between an European and a Sinhalese, 10 between Burghers and Sinhalese, 1 between a Burgher and a Tamil, 29 between Sinhalese and Tamils, and 1 between a Kaffir and a Sinhalese.

10. *Signatures in Marriage Register.*—Of the 8,950 persons married in the general community during the quarter, 987 men and 3,086 women signed the register with marks; that is to say, 22 per cent. of the men and 69 per cent. of the women could not write their names. Of the 3,546 Kandyans married, 568 men and 1,664 women signed the registers with marks, *i.e.*, 32 per cent. of the men and 94 per cent. of the women could not write their names.

### III.—Births and Deaths.

11. *Births.*—The births registered during the quarter numbered 36,700 (55 Europeans, 188 Burghers, 26,609 Sinhalese, 7,250 Tamils, 2,439 Moors, 97 Malays, and 62 Others), and were in the proportion of 38·4 per 1,000 persons living, as against 34·5 in the previous quarter, and 42·2, the average of the corresponding quarter in the period 1898–1903.

12. *Deaths.*—The number of deaths registered during the quarter amounted to 23,814 (34 Europeans, 113 Burghers, 15,374 Sinhalese, 6,264 Tamils, 1,859 Moors, 96 Malays, and 74 Others), and were equal to an annual rate of 24·9 per 1,000 persons living, as against the average of 28·5 for the fourth quarter in the period 1898–1903 and 23·7, the rate in the preceding quarter.

13. The births and deaths and their rates are compared in the following Table A with the results obtained in the previous quarter, the corresponding quarter of the previous year, and the average rates for the fourth quarter in 1898–1903.

14. *Sex.*—Of the total number of births (36,700), 18,837 were of males and 17,863 were of females, i.e., 1,055 males to 1,000 females. Of the total number of deaths (23,814), 12,185 were of males and 11,629 were of females. Out of equal numbers living of each sex, there died 922 males to 1,000 females.

15. *Infantile mortality.*—The deaths of infants under one year of age numbered 6,827, and were in the proportion of 186 to 1,000 registered births. The rate of infantile mortality varied in different districts from 459 (for Tamils) in Mannar, 436 (for Sinhalese) in Batticaloa, 412 (for Tamils) in Puttalam, 399 (for Moors) in Puttalam, 360 (for Tamils) in Mullaitivu, 330 (for Tamils) in Trincomalee, 295 (for Sinhalese) in Anuradhapura, 288 (for Sinhalese) in Badulla, and 240 (for Sinhalese) in Puttalam, to 130 (for Sinhalese) in Matara, 128 (for Sinhalese) in Chilaw, 126 (for Sinhalese) in Negombo, 120 (for Sinhalese) in Colombo, 116 (for Sinhalese) in Galle, and 113 (for Sinhalese) in Kalutara.

16. Forty-eight deaths (29 males and 19 females) were reported to be of centenarians, but the ages stated cannot be relied on.

#### IV.—State of Public Health.

17. The general health of the population during the quarter was good, the death-rate of the Island for the quarter (24·9) showed an improvement on the average (28·5), the improvement being shown in seven of the nine Provinces.

18. Tables III., IV., and V. in the Appendix show the number of births and deaths registered in the several Provinces and districts of the Island and in the revenue subdivisions of those districts for the quarter under review, and the average for the corresponding period in the last six years 1898–1903. The birth- and death-rates for all ages and for infants in the several Provinces and districts of the Island are shown for the Sinhalese only in the districts which are mainly inhabited by the Sinhalese, and for Tamils only where Tamils form the bulk of the population. In the Puttalam and Batticaloa Districts, which contain a resident population composed of Sinhalese, Tamils, and Moors, the rates are given for each of these races.

19. *Western Province.*—This Province, which on the first day of the quarter was estimated to contain 809,210 Sinhalese (who form the bulk of its inhabitants), showed a Sinhalese death-rate of 17·4 per mille per annum and was as usual the healthiest of the Provinces in the Island. The death-rate for the quarter showed an improvement on the average (20·0), but the birth-rate (34·5) deteriorated from the average (40·1). Each of its three districts, Colombo, Negombo (the healthiest district in the Island), and Kalutara, appears to have enjoyed better health than usual, their death-rates for the quarter being 17·5, 15·1, and 18·9, as against their respective averages 19·8, 18·1, and 21·8. The deterioration in the Provincial birth-rate was shared by all the three districts.

20. *Central Province.*—The Central Province recorded a death-rate of 30·0 for the quarter, showing a reduction of 3·4 from the average (33·4). All three districts of the Province, of which the Kandy District (29·2) was the healthiest and the Matale District (33·0) the unhealthiest, showed lower death-rates than the average. The improvement was greatest in the Matale District, where the death-rate declined to 33·0 from an average of 40·4. The death-rate in the Nuwara Eliya District was 29·4, as against the average 32·0. The births registered in the Provinces recorded an annual rate of 45·8 per mille per annum, as against the average 53·0.

21. *Northern Province.*—The death-rate among the Tamils of the Northern Province amounted to 26·4 per 1,000 during the quarter, and showed an improvement on the average (29·8). The birth-rate (32·6), however, showed a deterioration from the average (38·9). The improvement in the death-rate was solely due to the Jaffna District, which contains a Tamil population of 306,461. In the other two districts the death-rates were greatly in excess of the average, Mannar showing a rate of 41·5 as against its average 34·2, and Mullaitivu 57·8, as against an average of 36·4. The birth-rates in Mannar and Mullaitivu Districts were 41·5 and 46·8, as against their respective averages 33·8 and 37·2.

22. *Southern Province.*—The inhabitants of this Province appear to have enjoyed better health than usual their death-rate during the quarter falling to 22·5 per 1,000 per annum from an average of 26·0. The improvement was confined to the Galle and Matara Districts. In the Galle District the rate of mortality fell to 19·8 from an average of 27·2, and in the Matara District to 23·6 from the average 25·4. In the Hambantota District the death-rate deteriorated in the quarter from an average of 24·4 to 26·7. The Provincial birth-rate was 43·5 and the average 50·2. The birth-rate in the districts ranged from 47·0 in Hambantota to 40·4 in Galle. The birth-rate in Matara District (45·4) showed a decline of 5·3 per 1,000 on the average 50·7.

23. *Eastern Province.*—The rate of mortality among the Tamils of this Province during the quarter rose to 35·0 from an average of 30·2. The Tamil death-rates in the Batticaloa and Trincomalee Districts were 33·2 and 43·1, as against their respective averages 30·0 and 36·9. In the Batticaloa District the Sinhalese and Moors also fared worse than usual during the quarter, the former showing a death-rate of 43·2 against an average of 36·2 and the latter 33·8 against the average 24·8. The birth-rates of the district for the Tamils, Moors, and Sinhalese were 42·3, 56·2, and 28·3 for the quarter, and the average 53·2, 51·9, and 43·8 respectively.

24. *North-Western Province.*—The Sinhalese death-rate in the North-Western Province showed a diminution of 5·5 per 1,000 below the average 29·3. The improvement in health was shared by all its three districts, of which the Kurunegala District, containing more than three-fourths of the Sinhalese population of the Province, showed the largest reduction, viz., 6·8 per 1,000 from an average of 32·5 to 25·7 in the quarter. In Puttalam the improvement in the health of the Sinhalese was nominal, their death-rate (30·3) having fallen only 5 per 1,000 below the average. The Tamils showed a much higher death-rate (40·5) than the Sinhalese, and the Moors a still higher rate (50·4). The death-rates of the Tamils and Moors are in advance of their average rates 32·0 and 42·7 respectively. The Chilaw District, which is the healthiest district in the Island next to Negombo, showed an improvement in health during the quarter, its death-rate (15·9) being 1·3 per 1,000 below the average. The birth-rates among the Sinhalese in the Province and in the districts of Kurunegala and Chilaw were more than double their death-rates.

25. *North-Central Province.*—This Province experienced slightly worse health than usual. The Sinhalese death-rate (40·6) was about 1 per 1,000 higher than the average (39·5). With the exception of the Sinhalese in the Eastern Province, who however number less than 9,000, the North-Central Province showed the highest infantile mortality in the quarter, 295 per 1,000 registered births.

26. *Province of Uva.*—This Province was the unhealthiest in the Island during the quarter. Its death-rate (49·9) is nearly 2 per 1,000, below the average, but more than 6 per 1,000 higher than the rate for the corresponding quarter of the previous year. The birth-rate of the Province (53·2) showed a decline of more than 4 per 1,000 from the average (57·3).

27. *Province of Sabaragamuwa.*—The deaths registered in this Province presented a rate of 27·9 per 1,000 per annum, and showed a reduction of nearly 3 per 1,000 from the average (30·7). This was due to the improved health enjoyed by the Kegalla District, the more populous of the two districts in the Province. In this district the death-rate (22·6) was nearly 4 per 1,000 below the average, (26·4). The Ratnapura District fared worse than usual, its death-rate (34·6) showing an excess of about 2 per 1,000 on the average. The birth-rate in the Province (47·3) showed a diminution of 4·5 per 1,000 on the average (51·8). The birth-rates in both Kegalla and Ratnapura Districts (50·4 and 43·4) were lower than their respective averages (52·8 and 50·4).

#### V.—Causes of Deaths.

28. The causes of deaths registered in the Island during the quarter are given in Table X., and are summarized below:—

29. *Fever and diarrhoeal diseases.*—Of the 23,814 deaths registered in the Island during the quarter 4,680 were due to diarrhoeal diseases, and 4,484 were reported as due to various kinds of fever, i.e., fever and diarrhoeal diseases contributed more than 38 per cent. of the total number of deaths.

30. *Cholera.*—Four deaths from cholera were registered during the quarter. These were of sailors on board the ss. "Torridge" which arrived early in November from Bassein. One of the deaths occurred on board the steamer immediately on arrival and the other three at the Infectious Diseases Hospital at Kanatta, to which the patients were removed for treatment.

31. There were 28 deaths from measles (8 in Nuwara Eliya, 6 each in Kalutara and Kandy, 4 in Colombo, 3 in Matale, and 1 in Galle). Influenza accounted for 13 deaths (6 in Nuwara Eliya, 3 in Kandy, 2 in Colombo, and 1 each in Galle and Hambantota); 11 deaths resulted from whooping cough (2 each in Kalutara, Jaffna, Mannar, and Chilaw, and 1 each in Matale, Nuwara Eliya, and Mullaithivu); 6 deaths were due to chickenpox (4 in Kandy and 1 each in Nuwara Eliya and Galle). Diphteria caused 3 deaths, all of which were in the Colombo District.

32. The other chief causes of deaths were infantile convulsions 2,457, debility (mostly of infants from inability to suck) 1,300, phthisis 901, general dropsy 683, pneumonia 678, anaemia 663, old age 579, worms 574, puerperal convulsions 282, premature birth 260, undefined accidents of childbirth 222, rheumatism 198, bronchitis 189, malarial cachexia 179, tetanus 140, paralysis 126, dochmias duodenalis 94, puerperal fever 91, scrofula 73, diseases of the liver 62, asthma 61, cancer 54, varicose veins 47, and enteritis 23.

33. *Deaths by violence.*—Of the 386 deaths attributed to accidents, 91 were due to drowning, 54 to falls from trees, 38 to burns and scalds, 35 to snake bite, 21 to gun-shot wounds, 20 to falls of heavy substances, 18 to poison, 6 to falls from heights other than trees, 6 to being struck by lightning, 4 to injuries caused by hornets, 4 to falls, 3 to injuries caused by crocodiles, 3 to injuries caused by bulls, 2 to being run over by train, 2 to injuries caused by buffaloes, 1 to being run over by a cart, 1 to an explosion in a plumbago pit, 1 to injuries caused by an elephant, 1 to a fall into a well, 1 to injuries caused by a wild boar, 1 to injuries caused by a tiger, 1 to injuries caused by a Brahmin lizard, and 1 to an overdose of arrack.

34. *Suicide.*—Forty deaths were attributed to suicide, of which 26 were by hanging, 5 by drowning, 5 by poison, and 3 by gun-shot wounds.

35. *Homicide.*—Thirty-three deaths were due to homicide (6 in Hambantota, 5 in Kurunegala, 3 each in Kalutara, Galle, and Matara, 2 each in Colombo, Negombo, Mannar, Ratnapura, and Kegalla, 1 each in Batticaloa, Chilaw, and Badulla).

36. *Executions.*—There were seven judicial executions registered during the quarter (3 in Colombo, 2 in Matara, and 1 each in Kandy and Galle).

#### VI.—Health of the Estate Population.

37. The total number of births reported for registration from the estates of the Central, Uva, and Sabaragamuwa Provinces, and in the Colombo and Kalutara Districts of the Western Province was 2,786 (4 Europeans, 9 Burghers, 106 Sinhalese, 2,641 Tamils, 19 Moors, 6 Malays, and 1 Other), and the total number of deaths was 2,017.

(1 Burgher, 17 Sinhalese, 1,992 Tamils, 5 Moors, and 2 Others), corresponding respectively to an annual birth-rate of 26·2 and a death-rate of 19·0, as against the respective averages of 21·3 and 25·3. The causes of death are given in Table XI., and may be summarized as follows:—

39. *Kandy District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Kandy District was 951 (of which 903 were Tamils, 32 Sinhalese, 9 Moors, 2 Europeans, 2 Burghers, 2 Malays, and 1 Other), and the deaths numbered 648 (643 Tamils, 3 Sinhalese, 1 Moor, and 1 Other). The birth-rate during the quarter was equal to 24·2, as against an average of 23·2 for the corresponding period of 1898–1903; and the death-rate was equal to 16·5, as against an average of 27·4. The most fatal cause of death was debility (mostly of infants from inability to suck), which accounted for 166 deaths. The other chief causes of deaths were diarrhoeal diseases 155 (77 from diarrhoea and 78 from dysentery), pneumonia 48. Infantile convulsions 44, fever 33, general dropsy 30, dochmimus duodenalis 27.

40. *Matale District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Matale District amounted to 173 (168 Tamils, 3 Sinhalese, 1 Moor, and 1 Malay), and the deaths numbered 153 (152 Tamils and 1 Other). The birth-rate for the quarter was equal to 26·2, as against an average of 20·6; and the death-rate was 23·2, as against the average 34·1. Diarrhoeal diseases caused 42 deaths. The other principal causes of deaths were debility (mostly of infants from inability to suck) 23, malarial cachexia 19, pneumonia 12, general dropsy 12.

41. *Nuwara Eliya District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Nuwara Eliya District amounted to 700 (666 Tamils, 23 Sinhalese, 5 Moors, 4 Burghers, and 2 Europeans), and the deaths numbered 525 (521 Tamils, 3 Sinhalese, and 1 Moor). The birth-rate for the quarter was equal to 26·8, as against the average 18·6; and the death-rate was 20·1, as against the average of 17·5. Debility (mostly of infants from inability to suck) was responsible for 136 of the deaths. The other chief causes of death were diarrhoeal diseases 129 (73 from diarrhoea and 56 from dysentery), pneumonia 44, infantile convulsions 30, fever 28, dropsy 16, and old age 15.

42. *Badulla District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Badulla District amounted to 435 (426 Tamils, 6 Sinhalese, 2 Malays, and 1 Moor), and the deaths numbered 247 (246 Tamils and 1 Sinhalese). The birth-rate during the quarter was equal to 33·3, against an average of 23·9; and the death-rate was equal to 18·9, against an average of 22·6. The principal causes of death were general debility (mostly of infants from inability to suck) 55, diarrhoeal diseases 40, pneumonia 33, fever 28, infantile convulsions 21.

43. *Ratnapura District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Ratnapura District amounted to 103 (91 Tamils, 8 Sinhalese, 2 Moors, 1 Burgher, and 1 Malay); and the deaths numbered 100 (98 Tamils, 1 Sinhalese, and 1 Moor). The birth-rate for the quarter was equal to 24·5, as against an average of 26·0, and the death-rate was 23·8, as against an average of 35·5. The chief causes of death were diarrhoeal diseases 31, debility 24, malarial cachexia 12, and infantile convulsions 8.

44. *Kegalla District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Kegalla District amounted to 277 (256 Tamils, 19 Sinhalese, and 2 Burghers), and the deaths numbered 218 (213 Tamils and 5 Sinhalese). The birth-rate for the quarter was equal to 26·4, as against the average 23·8; and the death-rate was equal to 20·7, as against the average 31·9. The chief causes of death were diarrhoeal diseases 74, debility 19, dochmimus duodenalis 25, malarial cachexia 16, infantile convulsions 11, fever 9, and pneumonia 8.

45. *Colombo District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Colombo District amounted to 28 (26 Tamils and 2 Sinhalese), and the deaths numbered 43 (42 Tamils and 1 Burgher). The birth-rate for the quarter was equal to 13·3, as against the average 17·4; and the death-rate was equal to 20·5, as against the average 35·7. The chief causes of death were diarrhoeal diseases 11, fever 10, general dropsy 5.

46. *Kalutara District*.—The total number of births reported for registration from the estates in the Kalutara District amounted to 119 (105 Tamils, 13 Sinhalese, and 1 Moor), and the deaths numbered 83 (77 Tamils, 4 Sinhalese, and 2 Moors). The birth-rate for the quarter was equal to 27·8, as against the average 21·2; the death-rate was equal to 19·4, as against the average 43·3. The chief causes of death were diarrhoeal diseases 28, debility 13, pneumonia 8, and general dropsy 7.

## VIII.—Health of the Town of Colombo.

47. The births registered in the town of Colombo numbered 916, and corresponded to an annual rate of 21.7 per mille, being 2 per 1,000 below the average (23.7) for the corresponding quarters in 1898-1903.

48. The deaths registered numbered 1,189. To these has been added one death of a town resident which occurred in the Infectious Diseases Hospital, Kanatta (outside the town limits), and which was registered by an extra urban registrar, making a total of 1,190 deaths and corresponding to a rate of 28·2 per mille per annum, a fall of 6·2 per 1,000 below the average 34·4.

49. As usual in the town, the death-rate exceeded the birth-rate, due mainly to the preponderance of males over females (chiefly among the Europeans, Indian Tamils, and Moors), to the presence of hospitals, which add to the normal mortality of the town, and to the registration of births being still somewhat defective.

50. The subjoined Table E gives the births and deaths and their rates for each race for the fourth quarters of 1904 and 1903 and the average for the fourth quarters in 1898-1903 :—

51. Much reliance should not be placed on the rates given in the above table for Europeans, Malays, and the races classed together as "Others" owing to the smallness of the population. Excluding the rates for these sections, the lowest death-rate was among the Burghers (19·3, against an average of 23·3), followed by Tamils (23·7, against an average of 37·4). The highest death-rate was among the Moors (32·7). The Malays, who at the last Census numbered 4,493, show a death-rate of 36·1, as against 32·3, the average for the corresponding quarters in 1898-1903.

52. Next to Europeans, who show the highest birth-rate in the quarter (39·3, which is a rise of 3·9 per 1,000 over the average 35·4), come the Burghers with a birth-rate of 30·9 and the Malays with 30·5, as against their respective averages 33·2 and 27·3. The low birth-rates for Tamils and "Others" are due to their population being composed chiefly of males.

53. The number of births and deaths in each ward of the town, their rates per mille per annum, the principal zymotic causes of death, &c., during the quarter are shown in the following table F:—

54. The low birth- and death-rates of the Fort and Galle Face and the Pettah Wards are due to their population being for the most part a floating male adult. Excluding these two wards, the healthiest division in the town was, as usual, Kollupitiya Ward with a death-rate of 14·8 per mille per annum, and the unhealthiest New Bazaar and Slave Island with 30·0 and 28·4 respectively.

55. The death registered from cholera in the town during the quarter is one of the four cases already referred to in paragraph 30 of this report. There was one death from measles in the town.

56. Phthisis, bronchitis, and pneumonia were fatal in 281 (against an average of 270 in the corresponding period of the last six years), diarrhoea and dysentery in 172 (average 241), infantile convulsions in 113 (average 131), debility in 100 (average 101), fever in 76, including 41 of remittent fever (average 39), and 20 of enteric fever (average 20), tetanus in 71 (average 58), old age in 65 (average 76), paralysis in 25 (average 15), worms in 24 (average 19), diseases of the circulatory system 22 (average 30), enteritis in 13 (average 8), dochmiasis duodenalis in 10 (average 18), and anaemia in 8 (average 15), and parturition in 6 (average 21).

57. Thirteen deaths were attributed to accidents, of which 5 were due to drowning, 2 to burns and scalds, 1 to falls of heavy substances, 1 to gun-shot wounds, 1 to fall, 1 to injuries caused by a horse, and 2 to injuries at birth.

58. Two deaths were attributed to homicide and 1 to suicide.

### VIII.—Health of other Towns.

59. The following Table G shows the births and deaths and their rates for each of the principal towns of the Island for the fourth quarters of 1903 and 1904 with the average birth- and death-rates of the fourth quarters of the preceding six years:—

60. The death-rates for the quarter under report are given inclusive of hospital and jail deaths as well as exclusive. In some of the towns which attract large numbers of estate coolies and destitute poor to the hospitals, the difference between the two rates is striking, e.g., Matale 58·9 and 23·4, Kegalla 50·2 and 16·2, Kurunegala 53·9 and 20·9, Nawalapitiya 59·6 and 29·8, Badulla 54·9 and 25·9, and Ratnapura 47·0 and 27·7.
