## ACCUSED PERSONS WANTED.

**M**JUSEY PERERA ; charged with criminal breach of trust at Gampola on March 26, 1905 ; is a Sinhalese of the Karawe caste ; religion, Roman Catholic ; age, about 28 years ; height, 5 ft. 3 in. ; make, well built ; complexion, fair ; nose, prominent ; mouth, small ; teeth, well set ; eyes, black and round. ; was in the employ of J. C. deSilva & Co., Gampola ; hair, black and tied in a knot ; wears moustaches and beard cut short ; has white marks on the lips ; birthplace, Tudella in Negombo District ; haunts Polgahawela : is single ; friend, N. Silvestri Perera of Kandana ; is well known to the Headmen of Tudella, Kanuwana, and Kandana. The Police Magistrate of Gampola has issued warrant No. 35,784 for his arrest.

**KANSAWATTEGEDARA JUANIS APPU** ; charged with theft at Puliadda, Badulla, on June 11, 1905 ; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste ; religion, Buddhist ; occupation, cooly ; age, about 25 years ; height, 5 ft. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  in. ; make, stout ; complexion, brown ; hair, black and tied in a knot ; wears moustaches ; has a scar on one of the legs ; birthplace, Dehiwenna in Badulla ; general residence, Badulla ; haunts Bintenna and Passara ; is single ; brother, Appuhami of Dehiwenna ; is well known to Pedru Perera of Badulla and D. M. Punchiralla of Dikwella. The Police Magistrate of Badulla has issued warrant No. 7,029 for his arrest.
