THE TOLL ORDINANCE, No. 3 of 1896.

T is hereby notified that HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 10 of the Toll Ordinance, No. 3 of 1896, and with the advice of the Executive Council, has resolved that the toll established by resolution of the Legislative Council, dated August 17, 1904, in respect of the ferry over the Panadure river at Panadure in the District of Kalutara, Western Province, between the end of the old road on the west bank and the old landing place on the east bank near the Resthouse, be abolished as from and after the First day of July, 1905.
