NOTICE UNDER THE WASTE LANDS ORDINANCES, 1897, 1899, AND 1900.

TAKE notice, that unless within three months from the 27th day of March, 1902, the persons, if any, who claim any interest in the lands hereinafter mentioned or in any one or more of such lands, appear before the Special Officer appointed under section 28 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, and 1900," at his office at Galle and make claim to the said lands or any of them or so to some interest therein :

Such Special Officer, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by the said Ordinances, will declare by writing under his hand that the said lands or such of them, as to which no claim has been made, are the property of the Crown.



K. Don Thomas ; on the south by Batakandurehenyaya claimed by J. K. Don Thomas and others, Mahakumbura belonging to Gamage Janis and others, Mahakumburehena claimed by J. K. Don Thomas and others, Udakapatenuma belonging to G. Davit and others ; on the west by the village limit of Siyambalagoda, the village limit of Paragala.
