DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :--

An Ordinance for making provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the Year 1905.

HEREAS by Ordinance No. 22 of 1904 it was enacted that a sum not exceeding Twenty-one million Three hundred and Ninety-three thousand Four hundred and Nine rupees should be charged upon the revenue of this island for the contingent service of the year One thousand Nine hundred and Five, and it has become necessary to make further provision for the service of the said year: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 That a sum not exceeding Two million Seven hundred and Twenty-two thousand Three hundred and Sixty-four rupees and Thirty-two cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this island and other funds of the colony for the services hereinafter mentioned; and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the details of the estimates specified in the Schedule A hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract:

2 The Treasurer of the said island shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the revenues of the said island.

3 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.

Treasurer to pay the above at such times as the Governor by warrant shall order.

And to receive credit in his accounts for the payments made in pursuance thereof.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to make provision for the protection of the Pearl Fishery in Tampalakam Bay.

Preamble.

. •

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the protection of the pearl fishery in Tampalakam Bay: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Pearl Fishery (Tampalakam Bay) Ordinance, 190 ."

2 In this Ordinance the term "pearl oyster" means the molluse commonly called the "window oyster" or "the Tampalakam pearl oyster," and scientifically known as *Placuna* placenta.

3 The exclusive right of fishing for and taking pearl cysters in Tampalakam Bay within the limits defined in the schedule hereto is vested in the Crown.

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Short title.

Interpretation.

Prohibition of fishing for pearl oysters.

4 It shall be unlawful for any person within the limits afore aid to fish or dive for, or to collect, or to use or employ any boat, cance, raft, or vessel whatsoever for collecting pearl cysters, without having first obtained a license in that behalf from the Assistant Government Agent or from some person duly authorized by him to grant licenses.

5 Any person who, within the said limits, fishes or dives for or collects or uses or employs any boat, canoe, raft, or vessel whatsoever for collecting pearl oysters without having first obtained a license in that behalf in accordance with the last preceding section, or contrary to the terms of such license, shall be guilty of an offence, and shall, on conviction thereof, be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty rupees, or to simple or rigorous imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or to both such punishments; and any boat, canoe, raft, or vessel whereby such offence was committed, together with all its appurtenances and contents and all pearl oysters unlawfully collected, shall be forfeited.

6 It shall be lawful for any police officer or peace officer or for any fishery guard appointed under any regulation hereunder or for any officer of Customs to demand of any person found fishing for or attempting to collect pearl oysters, or having them in his possession, the production of the license required by this Ordinance; and if such license is not produced, or is not deemed satisfactory, to take such person before the police magistrate and detain in safe custody any hoat, cance, raft, or other vessel employed in contravention of this Ordinance, together with all its appurtenances and contents, until he shall have received the directions of the police magistrate for their disposal.

7 It shall be lawful for any police magistrate before whom any person shall be convicted of any offence under this Ordinance to direct a portion of the fine actually recovered and realized, not exceeding one-half, to be paid to the informer.

8 (1) It shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council from time to time to make, and when made to vary, amend, or revoke, regulations for the management, control, development, and improvement of the pearl fishery within the limits defined in the schedule hereto.

(2) Such regulations may, amongst other things, provide a close season, during which it shall be unlawful to fish for or to collect pearl systers within the said limits.

(3) All rules so made shall be published in the Government Gazette, and shall thereupon become as legal, valid, and effectual as if the same had been inserted herein, and shall be binding upon and be observed by all persons subject to their operation, and all courts, judges, and magistrates shall take judicial notice thereof.

(4) The breach of any regulations made in pursuance of this section shall be an offence, and shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding twenty rupees.

SCHEDULE.

That part of Tampalakam Bay or Lake lying to the westward of a line connecting the point near the mouth of the said Bay or Lake known as Semmalai with the point on the east side of the outfall of the Periya-aar known as Periatmunai.

THE object of this Ordinance is the protection of the "window oyster," which furnishes a small pearl fishery at Tampalakam Bay, near Trincomalee.

2. The exclusive right of fishing for these pearl oysters within the scheduled limits is vested in the Crown; fishing by unlice used persons is prohibited, and power is taken to make regulations for the management, control, development, and improvement of the fishery.
